

What do we WANT to know about trees?


Discussion Questions:

2. Conduct an experiment on the various elements needed to successfully grow a plant/tree.

Discussion Questions:

What impact does air, water and light have on trees/tree growth?



3 TASKS

- Explore what the children know about climate change (pair/group work).

Discussion questions – pair/group work

- What is climate change? What are the effects of climate change?
- Do we see effects locally or nationally in relation to climate change? Where? How?
- How does this impact on our trees and environment?

Thinking Questions - Identify and discuss

In groups, identify actions which harm the environment. Identify positive actions which can have an impact and prevent climate change. What is our role in this? What small positive actions can we take to play a part in preventing climate change? Does climate change impact upon anything other than trees?
