This is a restricted call for Green Recycling Enterprises Engaging in New Technology for a Circular Economy in Zambia (GREENTech4CE) an activity funded by the European Union and managed by Self Help Africa and its partners IMANI, Prospero Zambia and Tandem Circular Consulting.
