Job Purpose and Key Responsibilities :	The Deputy Chief of Party (DCOP) will be responsible for the overall technical oversight of the CNHA and is specifically responsible for project implementation that relates to the activity. The DCOP reports directly to the COP and will take a leadership role in ensuring technical implementation of high impact, proven interventions and ensuring the activity meets stated goals and reporting requirements.
	The DCOP supports the COP, acts for the COP as needed, and carries out any other tasks assigned by the COP to ensure proper management of CNHA. He/she will be responsible for operationalizing all aspects of the implementation of technical activities under CNHA. The DCOP is responsible for all operations including administration, logistics, procurement, budgeting, finance and compliance, property, and oversight of the Innovation Fund. The DCOP must ensure that implementation is in accordance with USG regulations and procedures and the specifications determined in the Cooperative Agreement. This must include ensuring that all procurement processes are fair and transparent, reviewing financial compliance, and monitoring the Innovation Fund and subcontract implementation.
