
#### **Empowering Africa Award Honoree**



# **WOMEN'S BUSINESS CENTERS**

Self Help Africa's Women's Business Centers (WBCs) are an innovative way to support women entrepreneurs realise their business dreams.

Adopting a model that has been operating successfully in Bangladesh for a decade, WBCs are now being piloted by Self Help Africa in three African countries – Malawi, Kenya and Nigeria.

A one-stop shop where women members can access digital and office services, marketing support and information, the new Women's Business Centers are also a hub where women can share their experiences and access training and mentoring support.

20 new Women's Business Centers, established in Nigeria this year, are supporting 2,000 women to further their business plans. Owned and run by women members, these grassroots centers, once fully operational, will support up to 60,000 people in Nigeria, in 2024.

In her community, Mercy David has used the support she has received from her local center to set up a business that trades in soap and hygiene products, sold to market traders in her community.

> Born initially out experiences she witnessed during the COVID-19 pandemic, Mercy recognized that market traders could maintain higher standards of hygiene surrounding food products in the markets is they had access to, handwashing stations, soap and even gloves. By responding to a market opportunity, Mercy's business has flourished.
